

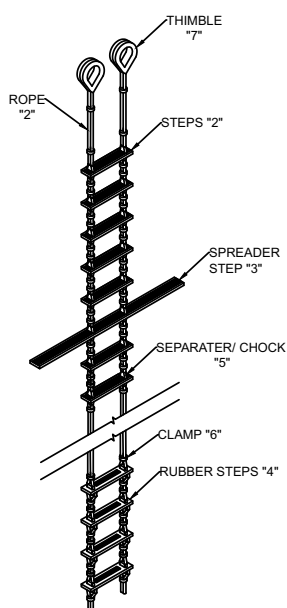

PILOT LADDER | CODE:M03101



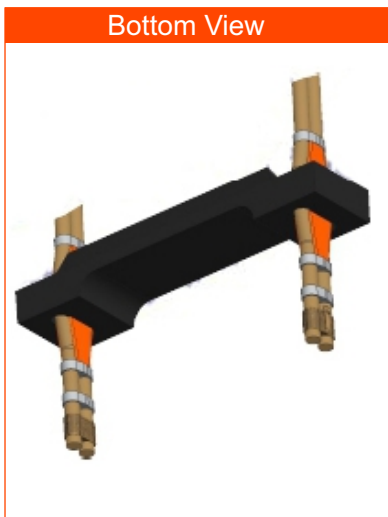
Pilot ladders remain the most safe and efficient way to board ships at sea. Nevertheless, a number of pilots have died/been injured due to defects in the ladder treads, side ropes or a lack of proper attachment of the ladder to the vessel. As per IMO, Shipping companies have a legal obligation to ensure that their ladders are SOLAS compliant, replacement ladders are readily available on board, and their seafarers receive necessary training.

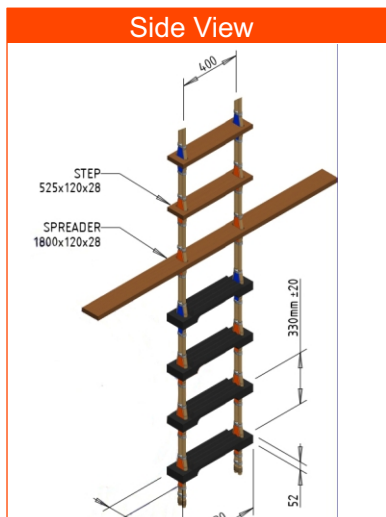


Rope	: Manila Rope, 20mm Diameter continuous with no joints
Length	: As per customer specification
Standard	: SOLAS, LSA Code, ISO 5489
Equipment	: Steps, Rope, Clamp
Steps	: Wooden Non-skid/Anti slip
Distance between steps	: 300 mm - 380 mm
Certification	: ABS Load Test Certificate
Mounting Details	: Two eye splices at top of the ladder with non-corrosive metal thimbles
