IMMEDIATE SUPPORT VESSEL (ISV)

The Immediate Support Vessel is a lightly armed surface vessel capable of operating in a sea state up to State 6 for rapid insertion, extraction, and patrolling of Offshore Development Areas (ODAs). The ISV is capable of day and night surveillance to curb fishing menace, intercept small intruder vessels, and conduct anti-terrorist operations.

The ISVs also carry an inflatable rescue boat to enable quick movements for search and rescue by marine commandos. We have manufactured 14 ISVs to date which were purchased by ONGC and are now being operated by the Indian Navy as a Naval Warship.
